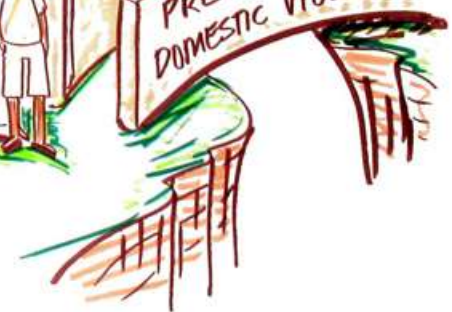

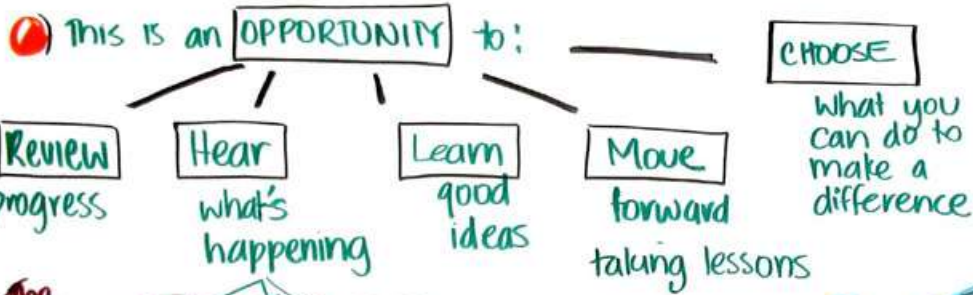

★ It is never too late to make change

★ You need to look past the behaviour - the story behind the front page

★ Sense of survival... ability to change her life from fear [breathing the air of terror]



★ It takes courage to speak out about life experience

★ Change is self initiating - within ourselves

★ Don't be quick to be judgemental - giving labels to behaviour

★ Encourage hope... that people can make positive change / heal... earlier

What we can do:-

✓ Don't label / judge

✓ More proactive services for support from many places

✓ The first opportunity to pick up difficulties was at primary school - importance of involving others - school / church

✓ Increase awareness / coordination eg. to schools / hospitals, etc.

✓ Better coordination of services

✓ Provide counselling

✓ We need to link with families

✓ Believe / trust from heart
